Boyle scored 68 goals and had 15 assists in 20 games as a junior midfielder to help Londonderry win its first New Hampshire state title. She was a co-captain and named a first-team US Lacrosse All-American after being an honorable mention All-American as a sophomore. She's a three-time first-team all-New Hampshire selection.

What did you do to draw the interest of NCAA Division I programs during the recruiting process?

It helped that I played for a club team – GSE [Granite State Elite], which is out of Milford. We went down to

Baltimore and the hotspots and we competed and did well. Without that I don't think I would have gotten the attention from the Division I programs. I did that for three years and worked my butt off doing that.
